

GNAWINS RAVEREVIEWS FOR U.S ELECTION COVERAGE



(VAGINAL CANDIDIASIS - THRUSH)

Vaginal Candidiasis, a.k.a vaginal yeast infection or thrush, is a fungal infection that causes irritation, discharge and intense itchiness of the vagina and the vulva — the tissues at the vaginal opening.

Thrush affects up to 3 out of 4 women at some point in their lifetimes, but sometimes that 4th women is also affected.

Many women experience at least two episodes, or an entire series if they are binging. A vaginal yeast infection isn't considered a sexually transmitted infection, but it does carry with it similar symptoms, smells and of course the social stigma. There's an increased risk of thrush at the time of first regular sexual activity. There's also some evidence that infections may be linked to mouth to genital contact (oral-genital sex/blowies/bj's/suck-jobs).

Yeast infection symptoms can range from mild to moderate, and include:

- -Itching and irritation in the vagina and vulva.
- -Vaginal pain and soreness
- -A burning sensation, especially during intercourse or while urinating, this particularly puts a damper on those interested in watersports!
- -Thick, white, odor-free vaginal discharge of a cottage cheese appearance (especially "Organic Valley" & "Marks & Spencer" brands of cottage cheese.

With promises of repayment through paypal or through the post, the conman took my e-mail and home address along with the tenner.


It was only after seeing the man break into a run upon parting ways did the victim think that maybe something was amiss.

The Glanmire Chicken Parade - Through the Years!

The Glanmire Chicken Parade has been going strong for 57 years now. It has, at times, gone in and out of fashion, and for several years after the turn of the century, the festival suffered mightily at the hands of animal rights activists. But one thing is for sure, it's not going away!

The festival started off with a bang, back in 1963. It was front page news at the time for a village to hold such an event so specialised in poultry. The 63' event was smaller in size, but chicken experts and historians maintain that it was the purists ideal of what a chicken parade should be. Some complain that the modern chicken parades have become too commercial or too international. They yearn for the old days and for the magic of the Glanmire Chicken Parade.

1997 saw the festival grow, with the first foreign winner of the famed "Cock of the Walk". Benoit, a Brahma Rooster from Rennes, took home the prize after achieving a perfect score from the judges. Tragically, we wouldn't see Benoit again the following year to retain his crown as the rooster perished in transport during the return journey to France. Benoit's coach Luc however, would be back, winning the award in 00' and 02', becoming the first coach to win the prestigious award three times with three different roosters.

Already billed as Donna V Raquel 2, this is certainly the pair of cocks on everyone's lips.



The original match-up back in 2019 ended in humiliating defeat for Raquel upon immediately fleeing the fighting ring. A common trait amongst younger roosters. However, this year Raquel has shown real maturity in recent bouts. The weigh-in last month almost saw the roosters come pecks thanks to some provocative posturing from Donna,



but this was later played down as just "Rooster Banter". The two will come beak-to-beak in the 1st round of the cockfighting tournament, one of the real thrils of the unseeded open draw.


